



## **Jump Rhythm Jazz Project Teen Workshop Scholarship Information**

There are a limited number of scholarships available for Jump Rhythm's Teen Workshop 2012.

Students interested in receiving one of the available scholarships are to submit a personal Rhythm Essay. Each essay must meet the following conditions to be considered.

The Rhythm Essay must:

- be 1 – 2 pages in length (typed and double-spaced),
- include one paragraph describing the applicant's training and experience,
- include one paragraph describing what the applicant knows about Jump Rhythm Jazz Project and the Jump Rhythm Technique™,
- include one paragraph describing what rhythm means to the applicant and why he or she wants to attend the Jump Rhythm Teen Workshop, and
- be submitted with a completed Teen Workshop registration form, and be received in the Jump Rhythm office by May 23, 2012. \*

Rhythm Essays will be reviewed by Jump Rhythm upon receipt, and scholarship recipients will be notified via e-mail by June 7, 2012.
